Definition	A Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS)-approved QCDR is an entity that collects clinical data from MIPS eligible clinicians (both individual and groups) and submits it to CMS on their behalf for purposes of MIPS. <sup>1</sup>	With claims-based reporting, measures reporting is tied to clinical practice reported on claims with CPT codes that link to measures.  Data submission must be done at the time the claim is submitted and is the responsibility of the eligible professional or group practice themselves or your billing company may offer this service for an extra fee <sup>2</sup> .	A qualified registry is a CMS- approved entity that collects clinical data from MIPS eligible clinicians (both individual and groups) and submits it to CMS on their behalf for purposes of MIPS. <sup>1</sup>

<sup>\*</sup>Eligible Measure Applicability (EMA) process: The EMA methodology replaces the Physician Quality Reporting System (PQRS) measure applicability validation (MAV) process. CMS will apply the EMA methodology to determine the number of measures a physician should have reported on when they reported on less than the required six quality measures in the quality category of MIPS.
